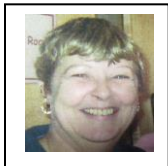

The Build

Work has now started on building the 4 new classrooms. As you are aware as from September 2016 Sandbrook became a 3 form entry school. We currently have 19 classes spread over Reception to Year 6 and eventually all years will have 3 classes, hence the need for additional classrooms. This will ensure that current and future pupils of Sandbrook will have a clean, safe and first class educational setting in which to learn.

Last week.....

Initial preparation for the build took place and a temporary fence was erected on the playground, to safeguard the perimeters of the build and to ensure pupil and staff safety.



This Week.....

Week 1 - Ground work starts on site this week. Digging and preparing the ground for the build will take place. There will be heavy machinery on site this week, including a 13 tonne excavator. Machinery delivery will take place before 8am and after 9am to avoid additional congestion at the beginning of the school day, however, please take extra care whilst travelling to and from school.

Parking



As the service car park is now closed, we are encountering additional parking issues to an already full car park. To help alleviate this issue there will be a member of staff present on the car parks before and after school, to ensure there is a constant flow of traffic.

There are a small minority of our parents who are still parking unsafely at collection and drop off times. Please do not block other cars in. We have 580 pupils at school and the car park was not designed to accommodate so many cars.

Traffic cones are being used to stop access to the side car park once it is full and the small car park at the front of school is for School staff and Children Centre staff parking only.

As a result of the building work, parents and staff will be parking on the surrounding roads and therefore space will be even more limited at the beginning and end of the day. It would be greatly appreciated and safer for your children if you were able to park in roads further away from the school and walk to the playground.

Disabled Parking

The disabled parking bays at the front of school are for disability badge holders only. Please ensure your badge is clearly displayed.
