The Build so far...

Work is now well under way on clearing the build site in preparation for ground works to start. The ground is being prepared for the next phase of the build.

Trenches are being prepared for drainage and services such as gas, electricity and water, which will service the classrooms.



Over half term....

Building works will continue over the half term break and over the next few weeks 'piling' will start. Piling forms the very basis of construction; the essential support needed for any kind of structure. It is a technique that sets deep foundations for any form of construction work.

This process can be very noisy as it involves drilling holes deep in the ground to lay foundations. However, to keep disruption to the school and classes closest to the build to a minimum, piling closest to the school will be carried out during the half term break.



Although the site is fenced and secured at night, some see the building site as a playground when the builders have finished work for the day. Please warn your children of the dangers of playing on building sites.



Parking



There are still a small minority of our parents who are parking unsafely both inside and outside the school grounds.


We have received complaints from local residents. Parents have been double parking, blocking driveways and in a few cases parking in resident's driveways. Please ensure when you park, especially on Hartley Lane, where traffic is at its highest at collection and drop off points, that you are considerate of local residents and parking regulations.

Within the school grounds traffic cones are being used to stop access to the side car park once it is full and access to the small car park at the front of the school is for employee parking only. Please try to avoid entering school grounds in your vehicle during peak times if possible as the volume and on occasion speed of traffic at the front of school could pose a danger to both pupils and pedestrians.


Please do not park in the drop off zone, at the front of school. This area is specifically for parent's dropping off children at Sandbrook and Crèche and Co.
