The Build so far.....



As you can see the new classroom build is progressing very well. It is now quite easy to see the footprint of the new extension and classrooms. The foundations are now in place and gravel has been put in and 'wackered', which is a process used to compress materials by using a machine called a compactor or 'wacker plate'! This is done to seal the ground in preparation for the pot and beam floor to be laid.



Above shows the start of the pot and beam floor being laid, this takes a 50 tonne crane to lift and position the flooring into place. Fun fact: 50 tonnes is about the weight of 6 African bull elephants!!!
