

Promoting and Celebrating Attendance and Punctuality at Sandbrook



At Sandbrook we have many ways to celebrate and promote good attendance at school and children who arrive punctually for school.



Breakfast Club: We offer a free Breakfast Club every morning which opens at 8.00am. Since our club began we have seen a positive impact on poor and late attendance. The children who attend have time to have their emotional needs met before school begins, and eat breakfast with their friends. We staff our club with very experienced and highly qualified staff, who all work in school alongside the children every day, therefore they know the children very well, and can meet their needs.



All the staff from our Nurture and Inclusion team in school works at our club. This means that we have staff on hand every morning to support children's emotional wellbeing from the minute they step foot in our building.



Whole School Attendance display: In our school hall we have our 'Rapunzel' attendance board. Each week we move the Prince up or down Rapunzel's hair – each class is aiming to reach **Rapunzel!**



Weekly Attendance Cup Winners: Each week we calculate the attendance percentage for the whole class. These figures are published on our website and displayed on our Rapunzel display. The class with the highest percentage in EYFS and KS1 are awarded an Attendance Trophy as are the class in KS2. The winning classes also get to choose a reward ticket for extra playtime, extra PE, extra free time or time on the iPads.



Weekly 'Punctuality Panda' winners: each week we calculate the punctuality percentage for the whole class. These figures are also published on our website. The class with the highest percentage for being on time in EYFS and KS1 are awarded our 'Punctuality Panda' as are the class in KS2. The winning classes get to look after the Panda for the week.



Improved Attendance Breakfast and Certificates:

At the end of each term we have a delicious Attendance Breakfast for children who have worked hard to improve their attendance. Bacon sandwiches and pancakes – yyyuummmm!



And FinallyPERFECT ATTENDANCE: Every day a class has 100% attendance they cross off a letter on the PERFECT ATTENDANCE poster. When every letter is crossed off they celebrate with a treat chosen by the whole class.
