As part of our PE curriculum your child will be going to Castleton Swimming Baths each week. Every child will take part unless they have a medical certificate to say that they are unfit to do so.

The first swimming session will take place on Thursday 15th September.

Class 14 will be swimming from 9.30am – 10.30am

Class 13 will be swimming from 10.30am – 11.30am

They will be travelling by coach – (safety belts will be fitted as standard).

Hair-bobble (for long hair)

Children with Grommets will need ear plugs. Children with verruca's will need a verruca sock.

Swimming and Behaviour

At Sandbrook we expect the best behaviour at all times. Before we go to the Baths the children will be reminded about their behaviour. If they misbehave whilst swimming, it is their choice and they will have to accept that they may be excluded from going.

I will not allow any child who's behaviour is unsafe or puts another child or adult at risk to go swimming. Please make sure you speak to your child about what behaviour is expected and the consequences of poor behaviour.
